

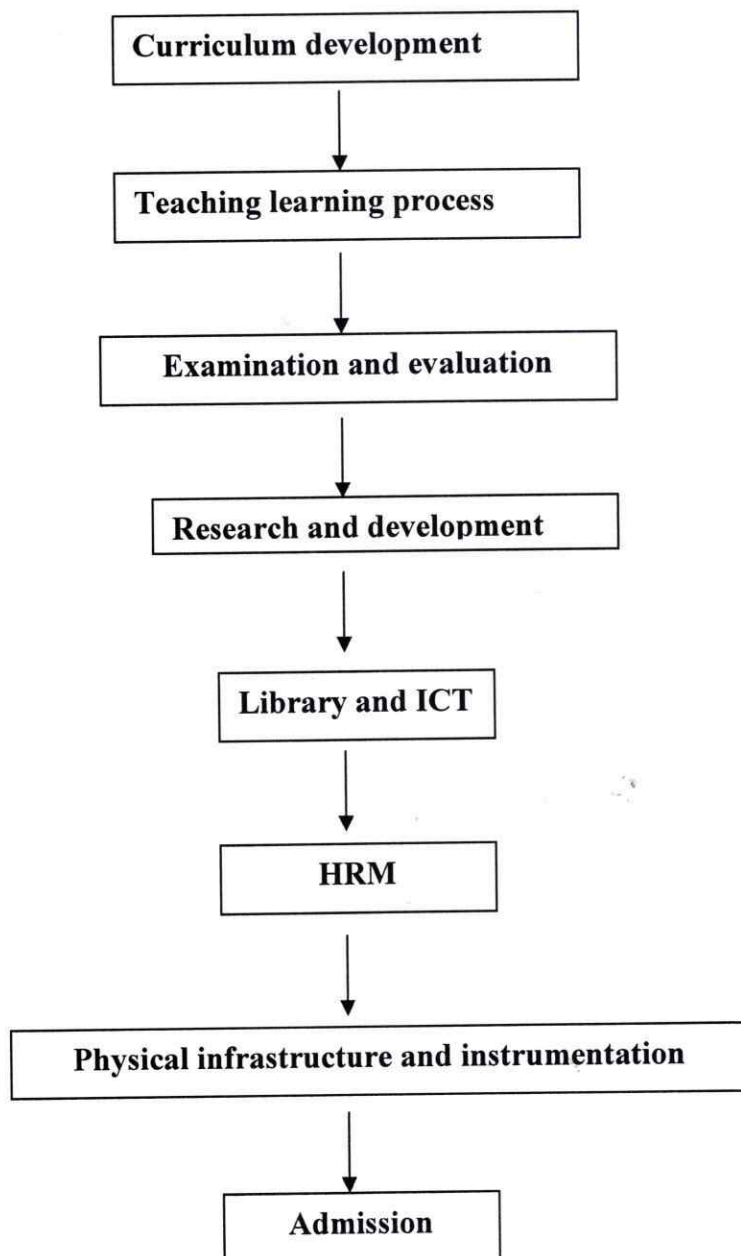

6.2.1. QUALITY IMPROVEMENT STRATEGIES FOR INSTITUTION PROVISIONS:

STRATEGIC PLAN BASED ON FOLLOWING LINES:



Shri Vitthalrao Joshi Charities Trust's, Samarth Nursing College was established in the year 2001 with 1 ½ year ANM course. In the year 2002, RGNM old course of three years duration was started. By keeping in mind the development of the society on all fronts, it was articulated that empowering women, making them self-sufficient and thus enabling them to live a life with respect is an important step in the development of the society. This vision has been made a reality by taking initiative to commence a course in Nursing in the vicinity of the hospital for the girls from Konkan region.

Curriculum development: The institute provides support for preparation of year plans (master rotation) for all the batches, schedules the institutional level examinations, class observations, student programmes, mentoring done by teachers to the students. As per the guidelines set by University, the Institute actively follows the curriculum which is given by INC for the smooth functioning.

Teaching learning process: The course outcomes are clearly stated in the syllabus. The institute has excellent library as a learning resource with good number of books and digital library. Slow/advanced learners are divided and proper action is taken. Seminars and conference are ongoing programmes for the students to keep them well informed and motivated.

Examination and evaluation: Institute is the Centre for the UG examination. As per the schedule of the examination by the MUHS, exams are conducted in the college as per the norms laid by the University. Institutional exam time table is prepared before the beginning of academics. Internal assessment marks are prepared and are displayed on the notice board after being verified by the students.


Research and development: The nursing students of both UG and PG are involved in research work as it is the requirement of the University. Every year number of students participates actively in the research work and are also encouraged to publish the research articles. Even the faculties are interested in publishing their research articles. The institute also took effort to conduct workshop on Research Methodology.

Library and ICT: The institute also provides good library which is computerized. The students can access PUBMED, MEDLINE etc. Adequate text books and journals are available, staff and students are benefited with this. The library provides nearly 2806 books along with national and international journals.

HRM: The institute pays particular attention to the recruitment of faculty. While appointing, the candidate is scrutinized by senior faculty at college. Institute takes keen interest in recruiting the faculty as per the need. The faculty is been benefited with good accommodation in the campus itself.

Physical infrastructure and instrumentation: The institute provides good assets for the students and employees as well. There are well ventilated classrooms with advanced teaching learning materials. Well equipped fundamental lab, Nutrition lab, Community lab, Pediatric lab, O B G Lab, Computer lab, Anatomy lab and A.V. Aids room are available. Campus also has ATM service. There good provision of water and electricity supply.

Admission: Samarth Nursing School approved by Maharashtra Nursing Council was inaugurated in February 2001. At present Basic B.Sc. Nursing Course of 4 Years, P. B. BSc. Nursing Course of 2 Years, M.Sc. Nursing Course of 2 Years duration, Auxiliary Nursing Midwifery (ANM) Course of 2 Years' duration and General Nursing Midwifery (GNM) Course (Revised) of 3 Years' duration (initiated from August 2002) are offered, for which hundreds of students are being admitted every year. The institution also provides accommodation for the students in hostels with the facility of a Hygienic Mess, providing wholesome and nutritious food. NEET is mandatory for admission of Basic BSc (N) program. Students need to fill the preference and then the admission process is completed.
