- 3) To discuss the staffing pattern of the Mahilaasharm
- 4) To describe the way of rehabilitation in the Mahilaasharm for girls and older women and also working women.
- 5) Enlist award received by the organization.

Establishment of organization 1st November, 1957

The purpose of organization:

- 1) Supporting destitute women and children.
- 2) Rehabilitation destitute women and children.
- 3) Providing care and education to the children.

Ways of rehabilitation:

Education, vocational training, marriage, adaptation scheme. These section have been done as per government formula.

- 1) Primary Junior and senior kinder garden
- 2) Observation of girls.
- 3) Hostel for working women
- 4) Peace home for older women

- 1) Primary Junior and senior kinder garden:

Establishment in 1965 this department admits girls in the age group of 0-18 years. Total 27 girls are going to primary junior and senior kinder garden.

- 2) Observation of girls:

Establishment in 1982 the department. Admit girls in the age group of 07-18 yrs. Girls admitted in government approved schools. In the year 2019-20, there were 15 entries in this department.

3) Working Women Hostel:

The organization has started this hostel so that the women coming from outside the village to work can stay safe well organized the organization has erected a well –equipped building with a grant from the central government.

Heals and accommodation are provided to the entrants for a small amount. Therefore needed women and girls taking advantage of it.

4) Peace Home for Older Women:

This section admits physically and mentally capable women. Provided with meals and accommodation for a small amount.

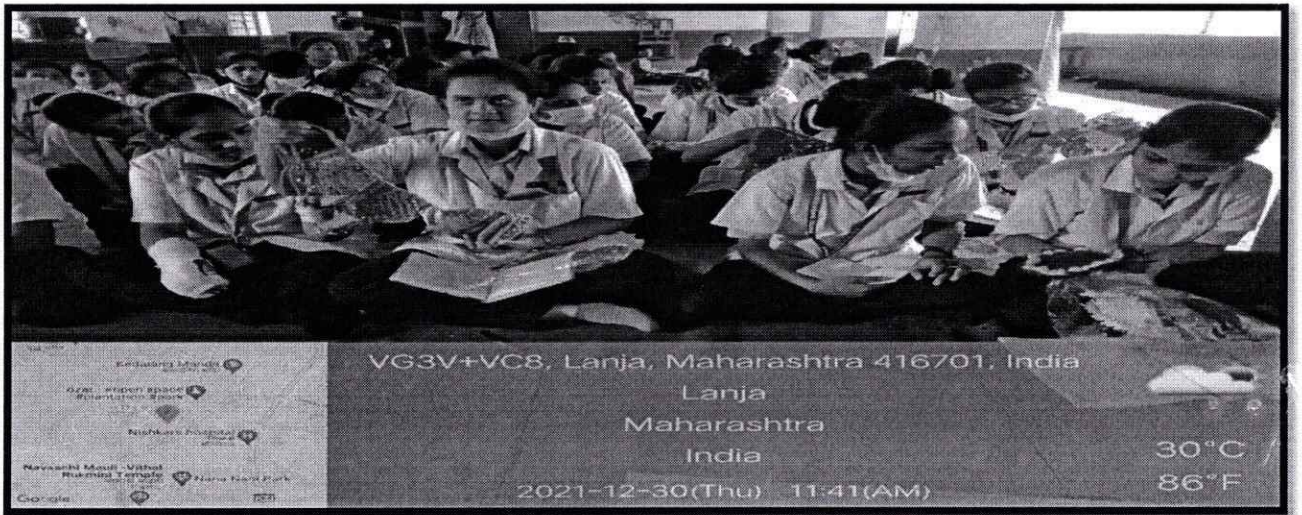

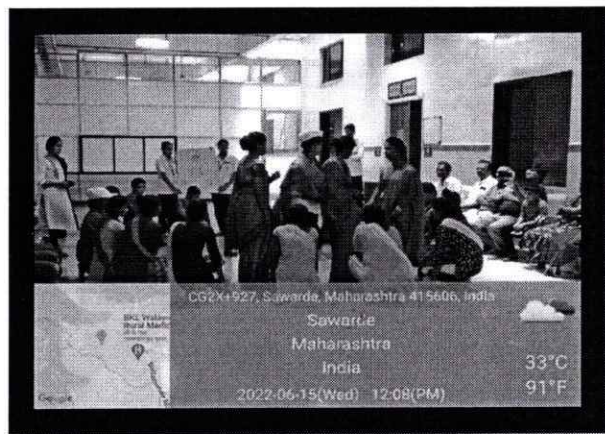
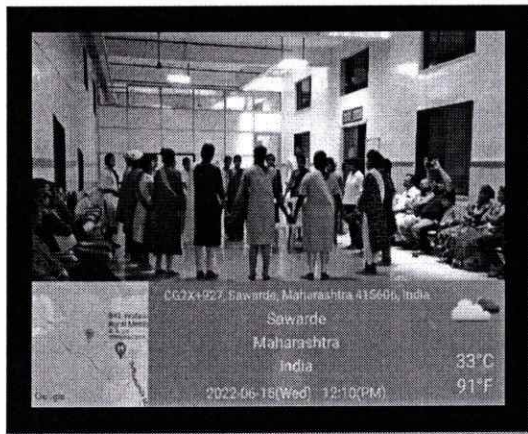
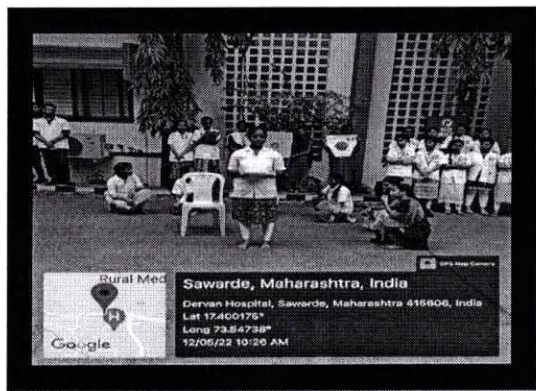
At the end the visit was very much interesting and informative.
