2. CPR SKILL PROCEDURE

What does high quality CPR do? - One of the best ways to improve a victim's chances of survival. Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) combines rescue breathing (mouth-to-mouth) and chest compression to temporarily pump enough blood to the brain until specialized treatment is available.

How to perform CPR procedure in adults?

- Bring the victim to a safe place.
- Check for the response.
- Call for emergency service.
- Check the airway
- Give 30 chest compressions.
- Give two rescue breaths.

CRP STEPS –DRS ABC

- D- Check For Danger
- R-Check For Response
- S- Send For Help
- A- Check Airways
- B-Check Breathing
- C- Cpr
- D- Defibrillator.

- This includes basic life support (BLS: airway, breathing and circulation support without the use of equipment other than a protective barrier device) and the use of an automated external defibrillator (AED)

3. Emergency Management And Advanced Procedure

The core topic of the workshop was emergency management & advanced procedure in critical care. The UK team during their lecture provided education regarding effective communication skills & its importance for nurses while interacting with the patients.

A demonstration on Basic Life Support was conducted in Skill lab for Basic B.Sc. students. The students were involved in mock demonstration of aseptic techniques, hand washing, gowning & gloving techniques, airway management, colostomy & tracheostomy care.
