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
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STUDENT NURSING COUNCIL

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

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REPORT ON FACULTY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME- PERSONALITY DEVELOPMENT


SVJCT's Samarth Nursing College organized Faculty Development Programme on

- Practical Exercises and Hands-on Learning





Breastfeeding is indeed the foundation for life and gives growing children a once-in-alifetimeopportunity to grow and develop to their full potential.



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
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Report on food mania

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
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
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REPORT ON RUN MARATHON 2024

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

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
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

process of a mother.









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
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
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After the completion of sessions, Prof. Tejal Surve - Vice Principal of the Nursing College handed over certificate of appreciation to the guest speakers.

The participants prepared the reels in accordance with the guidelines provided by the organizing team. Ten students participated in this competition, and the top three were selected for prize eligibility.



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

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


 Historical Context: The political scenario of India in the 17th century and the rise of Shivaji Maharaj.
