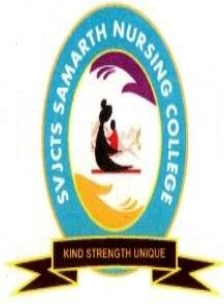
Report On Celebration Of Birth Anniversaries Of Dr.
